## **LOCAL RULES**

To be read in conjunction with the rules of golf

**OUT OF BOUNDS** – all areas outside the boundary edge of the course as defined by the club's boundary fences or boundary marked by white posts/stakes with black band

### ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (Rule 16)

- 1. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (including but not limited to)
- · All on course watering equipment and area of spray must be treated as immovable obstructions
- Fixed Sprinkler Heads in the general area, the player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if a fixed sprinkler head is;
  - . on the line of play, and is
  - · within two club-lengths of the putting green, and
  - · within two club-lengths of the ball

The ball may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point of relief in the general area not nearer the hole.

#### 2. NO PLAY ZONES

All staked trees and shrubs regardless of height are no play zones. Player must take free relief under Rule 16.1f

#### 3. GROUND UNDER REPAIR

If a player's ball is in the general area and there is interference from exposed tree roots that are in the general area that is cut to fairway height or less (or within two club—lengths of the edge of the ground cut to fairway height or less) the tree roots are treated as ground under repair. The player may take free relief under Rulet 6.1b (But interference does not exist if the tree roots only interfere with the player's stance)

ALTERNATIVE TO STROKE AND DISTANCE FOR LOST BALL OR BALL OUT OF BOUNDS — An alternative option for relief from a ball lost or out of bounds is provided by a local rule displayed on club notice board as per model local rules in Rules of 60ff 2019.

**DROP ZONES** – If during the play of holes 2, 4, 5,11,14,17 the ball crosses the margin of the penalty area between the green stakes, the player may under penalty of one stroke, drop the ball in the nearest dropping zone. Blue drop zone stakes mark drop zone position, drop within two club lengths not nearer the hole. The ball must be dropping zone and it must come to rest in the dropping zone.

PENALTY AREAS are marked by red stakes or lines

GROUND UNDER REPAIR (GUR) is marked by white stakes or lines

ALL DISTANCE MARKERS are measured to the centre of the green

GREEN STAKES INDICATORS are to identify the use of drop zones

Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for breach of a local rule is the general penalty (in stroke play – two strokes, in match play – the loss of the hole)
